DRAFT AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 28, FOOD REGULATIONS 1985

To include the definitions of ceramic cooking ware and maximum permitted proportion of lead and cadmium under Regulation 28, Food Regulations 1985: Ceramic Ware as follows:

• New Subregulation 28 (2):

(h) "cooking ware" means any ceramic ware which intended to be heated by conventional thermal methods or microwaves.

• Amendment of Thirteenth Schedule: Maximum Permitted Proportion of Lead and Cadmium Release
